Friday October 24

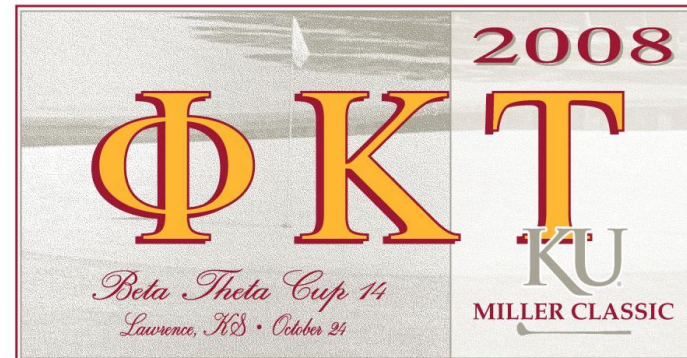
Damon Miller Classic Golf Tournament – 10:00 am.
